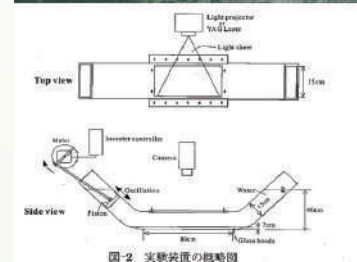
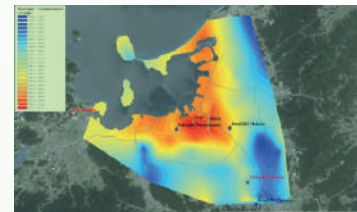


図-2 実験装置の概略図

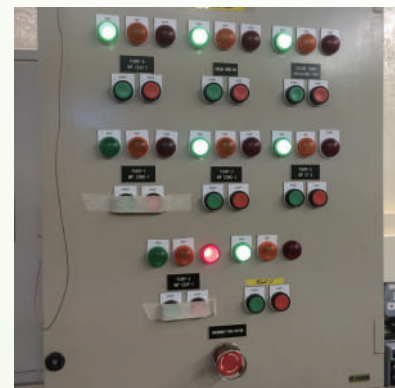


Uthpala Perera
